During the internship period, the intern learned skills and responsibilities of the job, the educational avenues they should pursue to better prepare themselves for a career in broadcasting, and at the end were given a final project to complete that proved to both SEU's supervisors and school administrators that students received a vast knowledge of broadcasting while studying with our employees.  Lee Family Broadcasting, Inc. offers internships for both high school and/or college credit, and for those not wishing to obtain school credit, but rather on-the-job experience. Several internships have turned into part-time hires, and qualified and available part-time staff members are always considered when filling full time vacancies.
